Why should I do this?

It will make you happy. You will feel the exquisite feeling of helping someone else who for whatever reason is far less lucky, at the moment, than you are.

Can I meet the person that is getting my gifts?

Sorry, no. Security and confidentiality are critical here, and for many reasons, the people on the receiving end of your kindness need to protect their privacy.

Who will receive my gifts?

Your goods are delivered directly to the client's new home.

Whose apartment is it?

The apartment is rented directly by the client. The shelter, called the Woman's Resource Center to End Domestic Violence, may pay the deposit for the apartment, but the client is then responsible for paying the rent.

How do I know what's needed?

We have a standard list on the website that allows the very basics to furnish a two bedroom, one bath apartment for the mother and usually one or two young children. As we receive items, we will adjust the "checklist" on the site so you can see where the urgent need is.

What if I have items that are not needed or already spoken for?

We'll still take them, gladly. As one "project" ends, another comes up, so the next client is going to need what you have, for sure.

What about delivery and pickup?

For smaller items, if you wish I can collect them at my office in Midtown: 1109 West Peachtree St NW, Atlanta 30309, and then I will be glad to arrange for pickup.

For larger items, we are in the process of procuring a warehouse, but we do have wonderful volunteers who will come to you without delay and pick them up.

What about a tax deduction?

The WRC (women's resource center) is a 501c-3 charity and therefore you are entitled to a letter, for tax purposes, describing the donation and the value.
